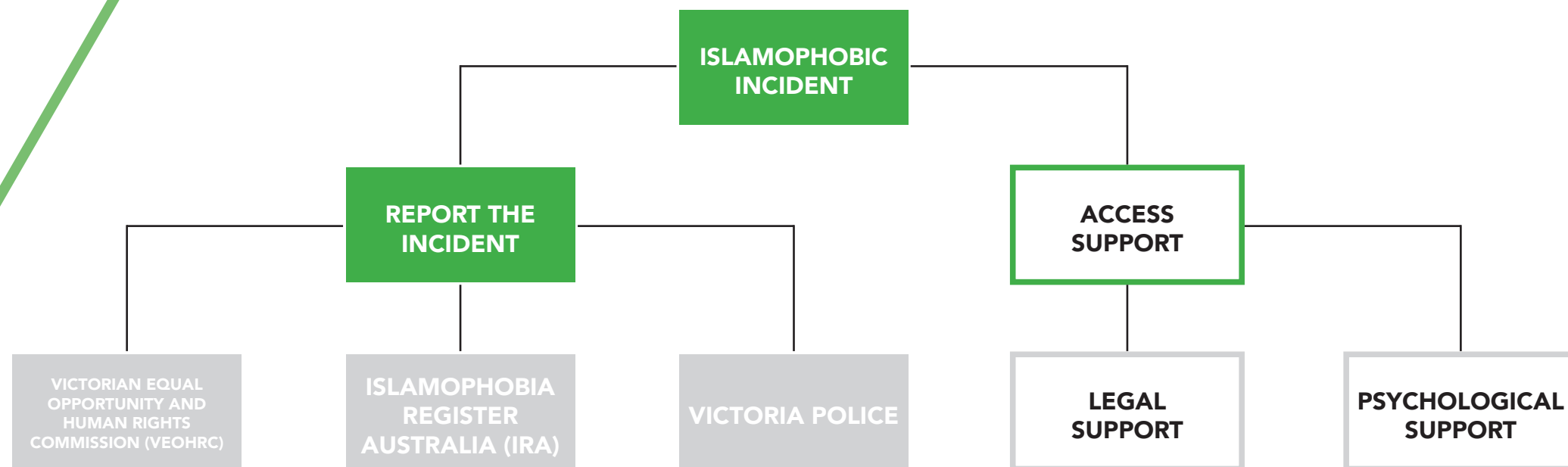


# RESPONDING TO ISLAMOPHOBIC INCIDENTS



**VICTORIAN EQUAL OPPORTUNITY AND HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION (VEOHRC)**

**ISLAMOPHOBIA REGISTER AUSTRALIA (IRA)**

The IRA is a secure and reliable platform that provides people across Australia with a place to report Islamophobic incidents. The IRA has a set protocol for reported incidents. Each incident is assigned a unique incident number and caseworker who will offer support, information and/or referral services.
